Stage 1: Cold Bore

Competitor will start in a standing position ensuring all shooting equipment is off the ground. Total time allotted is 90 seconds.

Competitor will assume a position of their choice and conduct:

One cold bore shot at 51 yards utilizing decimal scoring x3 on paper hostage target. The 1/2" X ring will be the point where the bridge of the nose intersects the top of the hostage takers eyes (Sample target will be provided.) Hits striking any part of the hostage will be marked 0. Possible point value is 30.

Two shots on steel at 450 yards. 10 points per hit as determined by the RO.

Two shots on steel at 250 yards. 10 points per hit as determined by the RO.

70 points possible.

Stage 2: Know Your Limits

Competitor will start in a standing position ensuring all shooting equipment is off the ground. Total time allotted is 5 minutes.

Competitors will maintain a standing position and conduct:

2 shots on a decimal scoring target at 100 yards standing. 20 points possible.

Assume a kneeling or sitting position:

3 shots on a decimal scoring target at 100 yards sitting or kneeling. 30 points possible.

Assume a prone position:

5 shots on decimal scoring target at 100 yards from prone position. 50 points possible.

Shooting positions can be supported.

Competitor will assume a position of their choice and engage:

Targets positioned at 150 yards, 250, 350, 450 will be engaged left to right. 10 points per hit. If any target is missed in the four-target shooting array, the competitor will lose any points accumulated on the four-target shooting array. The shooter may re-engage the array starting left to right until time expires.

140 points possible

Stage 3: Random Distance

Competitor will start in a standing position ensuring all shooting equipment is off the ground. Total time allotted is 4 minutes.

Competitor will assume a position of their choice and shoot:

Five targets of varying sizes arranged at random distances within the target array. Targets will be positioned at 275 yards, 350 yards, 475 yards, 515 yards, and 625 yards. Targets can be engaged twice. Each hit, as determined by the RO, will accumulate 10 points. Competitors will be allowed to range targets prior to engagement.

100 possible points.

Stage 4: Over a Barrel

Competitor will start in a standing position ensuring all shooting equipment is off the ground. Total time allotted is 4 minutes.

Competitor will assume a position in which the firearm is supported by a barrel or drum resting horizontally and conduct:

5 shots on a decimal target at 200 yards. 50 possible points

Competitor will assume a position in which the firearm is supported by a barrel or drum resting vertically and conduct:

5 shots on a decimal target at 200 yards. 50 possible points

100 possible points

Stage 5: Hit Factor

Competitor will start in a standing position ensuring all shooting equipment is off the ground. There is no time limit.

Competitor will assume a position of their choice and engage:

Six targets placed at 275 yards, 450, 325, 565, 200, 400. Each target must be engaged twice but may be engaged as many times as the competitor sees fit. Targets not struck will result in a 30 second penalty.

Stage will be scored utilizing Hit Factor Scoring (Points – Penalties/Time in minutes= HF score)

Score will make up 25 % of Tactical Score. 53 rounds minimum. center-fire ammunition, up to and including .308 inches or in excess of 3,200 feet per second muzzle velocity. Tracer, incendiary, and **steel core ammunition is prohibited.**
